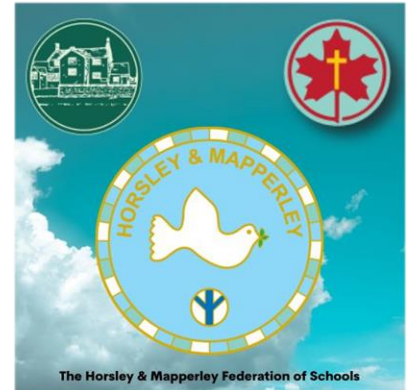

Dear Robin families,

Welcome back to a new year and a new term. This term's topic is "One Day, Many Ways" which is a thematic unit about children's lives around the world. Pupils will explore many aspects of life around the world through the lens of a typical day going to school. They will look at the foods eaten for breakfast and lunch, what different schools and school journeys look like and what children do outside of school time. There is a focus on geography and science.

. Our sticky knowledge will be:

- **How do children get to school?**
- **Where do children go to school?**
- **What do people eat for breakfast around the world?**
- **Why is exercise, nutrition and hygiene important to humans?**

In Maths we will be working on Multiplication and Division, as well as length and height for Year 2 and Perimeter for Year 3. In English we will be reading Lila and the Secret of Rain to write a narrative in the 3rd person, Schools around the World to write a non-chronological report and The Nothing to See Here Hotel, to write our own limerick. RE is taught every week on a Tuesday afternoon and the children will be studying the topic 'What we can learn from sacred books?'. PSHE is also taught on a Tuesday afternoon and the children will be looking at 'Being Healthy'.
